The project targets the priority of achieving a greener and more resilient border region between Romania and

Hungary.

The implementation period of the project is 30 months. The project is carried out in partnership with the Romanian commune of Biharrósa (Roşia). The total project budget is €2,442,157.23, of which €1,953,725.76 is the ERDF contribution, €433,761.88 is the national contribution of Romania and Hungary, and €54,669.59 is the contribution of the project's four partners.

**Project objective (RSO2.7):** To improve the protection and preservation of nature, biodiversity and green infrastructure—including in urban areas—and to reduce all types of pollution.

The project aims to enhance the protection and preservation of local and cross-border biodiversity in Biharrósa and Esztár by attracting **10,000 visitors annually** to both Biodiversity Observation Centres, thereby fostering community and visitor awareness as well as active participation in regional conservation efforts across the cross-border area.

We hereby respectfully invite you to the project's first Hungarian workshop, to be held on Thursday, 16 October 2025, from 10:00 at the József Attila Community Centre, Main Hall (address: 4124 Esztár, Kossuth utca 1).
